Connect:

Engage:

Read 2 Timothy 3:13-17

How do these verses answer the questions that people are asking about the necessity and usefulness of the Bible?

Which of these applications of the Bible has been the most fruitful in your life?

Robert outlined "4 Reasons Why We Can Trust the Bible."

- 1. Archaeology
- 2. Prophecy
- 3. Science
- 4. Eyewitnesses

Which of these reasons gives you the most confidence?

Robert introduced some concepts around "Textual Criticism" and its applications to how we get and study our Bible.

How does the number of manuscripts *and* the date of the copies from their original writing encourage you to trust the Bible?

In what ways have you seen the Bible inspired by God and inspiring for your life?

How have you wrestled with translation, grammatical errors, and scribal errors as you seek to trust the Bible?

Read 1 Corinthians 15:3-8

What hope do you gain from this passage?

Apply:

Studies show that people who engage with the Bible 5 days a week develop a reduced likelihood to engage in activities like drunkenness, loneliness, pornography usage, and gambling. It also results in an increase in self-esteem and a willingness to forgive.
