"We often live life between irritation and indignation."

Of these two, do you find yourself most often frequently irritated or deeply angry?

Engage:

Read Psalm 27:14, 2 Peter 3:9, Romans 2:4

Our view of patience changes when we remember that God is perfectly patient.

Have you ever been frustrated with God's patience and the detours and delays that He's sent your way?

How has encountering God's patience grown or challenged your faith?

Robert defined patience as "the capacity to live gladly in the current season when we would rather not."

Would other people describe you as patient? Why or why not?

Would other people describe you as relaxed? Why or why not?

Robert shared Dallas Willard's commentary that "Jesus was relaxed." In what ways do you see the life of Jesus as a relaxed life?

When was a time in your life that you weren't patient and wish you were? When was a time in your life when you demonstrated great patience and were glad that you did?

Robert gave us two ways to exercise patience:

Understanding (Proverbs 14:29, 1 Peter 3:7)

- Are you guilty of quickly jumping to conclusions and acting in impatience?
- In what ways do you think your lack of understanding of what someone else is going through has led you to be impatient?

Abiding (John 15:5)

- When your way of doing things doesn't work, what do you most often think and feel?
- Share a story from when you encountered an issue and were blessed by communing with God in a difficult time.
